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FOREWORD

I am really pleased to give details of various Programmes, activities, workshops, camps and lectures of eminent persons to improve the performance of students and to uplift the standard of learning and teaching, to impart knowledge effectively for the all round development of students. While organizing these activities, the centre of interest was always students.

This report clearly reflect the efforts taken by the college for the all round development of students. The number of activities, curricular as well as co-curricular and extra curricular, clearly show the hard work put in by the staff of our college.

The most noteworthy event in the last academic year was that the two Vice-Chancellors, Dr. N.K. Thakare, the founder Vice-Chancellor of North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon and the present Vice-Chancellor Dr. K.B. Patil visited our college. The college had organized the University level “Workshop on Friendship with various aspect of life”(Maitri Shibir). This three day workshop was inaugurated by Dr. N.K. Thakare and Dr. K.B. Patil was the chief guest of valedictory function.

To prepare our students to compete with the students of urban area, our college run “Eklavya Competitive Examination Centre”. The members of this committee invited IAS and IPS officers like Mr. Madhukar Gavit, DIG, Mumbai, Mr. Andhale, IAS officer of guide our students. Their experiences of M.P.S.C. and U.P.S.C. examinations was fruitful for the tribal students. Mr. Yajurvendra Mahajan from Jalgaon, who runs competitive examination centre at Jalgaon conducted one day workshop for 100 tribal students of our college. Asha foundation, Jalgaon organized a series of lectures through out the academic year. Mr. G.A. Kulkarni and his team of Asha foundation guided our students every Sunday and helped them in preparation for the competitive examination.

To uplift the standard of education and improve the performance of students, specially tribal students, the college with the assistance of U.G.C., implemented ‘Remedial Coaching’. This scheme helps students to understand the subjects properly. In the last academic year the college received the grant of Rs. 3,00,000/- from U.G.C. and the college utilized the grant of Rs. 2,60,000/- of it on this scheme.

The college also runs”Centre for Coaching and Career Planning”. The U.G.C. provided the financial assistance for this scheme. This committee organized workshops and lectures of eminent scholars. The total amount spent by the college on this scheme was Rs. 1,40,026/-. The four days workshop on ‘Disaster Management’ was organized by Department of Zoology in collaboration with Civil Defence Department, Ozar..

The college also runs vocational courses like CMLT, DMLT and certificate course in spoken English. For these two courses the college received the seed money of Rs. 10,00,000/- from U.G.C. With the help of this seed money the college has set up the advanced eye-speak-lingua- Lab for the students of English department. Mr. Jonas from Mumbai, conducted four days workshop for the teachers of the department of English for the effective use of this eye-speak-lingua- Lab in the teaching of English language.

In the last academic year the college introduced” Karmveer Bhaurao Patil Earn and Learn Scheme” with the collaboration of North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon. This scheme is specially for the economically poor students. The University assisted ten students and the helped three students. The college spent Rs. 25,890/- on this scheme.

The college helps poor students in every possible way. In the last academic year college gave Rs. 86,000/- for the poor students. The college also provided free hostel facility for economically backward students.

The college organized one day University level workshop on”Global Warming” for the students. This workshop was inaugurated by Dr. A.T. Patil, Principal, Visarwadi college. It benefited 125 students and forty teachers.

Besides this the N.S.S. unit, the Vivek Vahini, Tribal Welfare Student Committee, Debate Committee, Planning Forum, Literary Association, Science Association and Social Sciences Committee organized various Programmes for the all round development of students. The details of these activities are mentioned in the later part of this report.

Our management is very keen in providing, modifying infrastructure. This year with the financial assistance of U.G.C. grants college built Multi-Purpose Hall with the capacity of 500 seats. An up to date and well equipped ultra modern research laboratory in physics has been set up in the department of physics and the laboratory has become the matter of curiosity for many researchers in North Maharashtra University, who give visits to the laboratory. The Administrative office of the college is also modified. The cabin of the Vice-Principal and Staff –common room are also renovated.

I am proud to point out that two of our faculty members Dr. Dipchand Jaiswal, from the department of Zoology and Dr. Vijay Patil, the director of physical education received Ph.D. degrees in their respective subjects from Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University Aurangabad. Another faculty member Mr. J.D. Sali got M. Phil in English from Madurai Kamraj University. Mr. B.B. Kuwar, the head of the department of psychology received “Rajashri Shahu Maharaj Social Award” from the social organization, Shinde Dist. Nashik. Mr. I.G. Pathan, from the department of Physics won the Ist prize in the National Conference for his research paper presented in poster form at Bhusawal. The two teachers of the Botany department won the IInd prize for poster competition at International conference held at S.S.V.P.S’s College, Dhule. Two teachers of my college, Mr. I.G. Pathan and Mr. C.L Surwade have registered and engaged in their research work for Ph.D Degrees in their subjects. Mrs. S.B. Bansode and, Mr. A.B. Mahajan, Mr. S.R. Borse Mrs. C.S. Gavit and Mr. H.N. Kamble are the teachers in the process of registration for the research degrees in their respective subjects. Mrs. C.S. Gavit of the department of geography has passed the PET examination required for Ph.D registration.

The performance of the students of our college in sport is also remarkable. Eight students from our college represented North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon, in the inter-university tournament and Ashwamedha inter-university tournaments.

The management of our college is very liberal and co-operative. Without their generous support the implementation of these activities was not possible. I am really grateful for the valuable support of the management.

I hope you will consider that we work in the entire tribal area and judge our efforts to uplift the standard of higher education in our college. It will be ungrateful on my part if don’t mention your support and encouragement to us to uplift the standard of higher education.

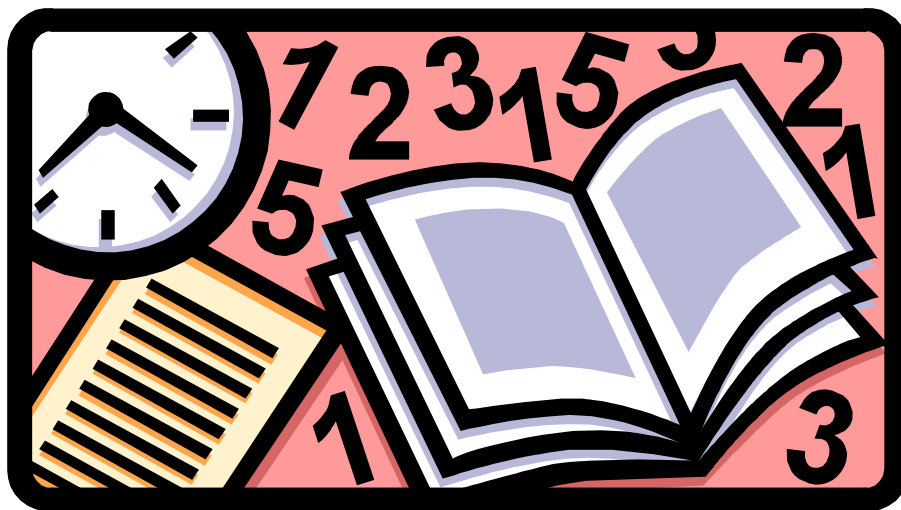

2. New academic programmes initiated:

The college sent the proposal for post graduate classes in the subject Hindi to the North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon. The University granted the permission and the post graduate classes in Hindi will be introduced in the next academic year.

From this academic year our college introduced computer science at special level for the B.Sc degree.

The college has also proposed to introduce two new vocational courses, Certificate course in web designing and Certificate course in computer applications respectively. The proposal of these two courses are submitted to the U.G.C. office.

3. Innovations in curricular design and Transaction:

The college has not the freedom to frame the curriculum as it is affiliated. Therefore we follow the syllabi framed and prescribed by the North Maharashtra University Jalgaon. However the faculty members contribute in designing the syllabi of various subjects as a member of the board of studies of the university

4. Inter disciplinary programmes started :

The college runs vocational course like CMLT, DMLT and certificate course in spoken English. Students from all faculties are allowed to join these courses. The teachers from the Dept of Zoology are invited to guide students of the certificate course in spoken English to help them to understand the respiratory system which is quite useful for them to understand speech mechanism.

5. Examination reforms implemented:

The college prepares students for annual university examinations by conducting practice examinations for general knowledge. The college conducts the university examinations as per the guidelines of the North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon.

6. Candidates qualified : Net/Set/Gate etc:

Two teachers from the department of Chemistry Mr. More and Mr. Chavan passed NET examination. Two faculty members from our college Mrs. C.S. Gavit from the department of Geography and Mr. Abdul Shaikh from the department of Computer Science passed Ph.D entrance examination and qualified for the Registration for Ph.D. in the respective subjects.

7. Initiative towards faculty development programmes:

The college encourages the faculty members for improving their qualification, updating the subject knowledge by attending refresher courses, orientation courses, Seminars Conferences and Research work. In the last academic year two of our faculty members Dr. Dipchand Jaiswal, from the department of Zoology and Dr. Vijay Patil, the director of physical education awarded Ph.d. degrees in their respective subjects by Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University Aurangabad.

Mr. J.D. Sali from the department of English received M. Phil degree in English from Madurai Kamraj University. Mr.I.G. Pathan from the department of Physics received the grant of Rs. 1,46,000/- for his minor research project and his project is almost on the verge of completion. Another faculty member Dr.R.A. Mali from the department of Hindi is also engaged in his minor research project funded by the university grants commission.

For the last academic year the college received the grant of Rs. 51,91,500/- out of which the grant of Rs. 24,63,705/- has been utilized. In the last academic year 52 Seminars/ Conferences/ Workshops at various levels were attended by the teachers of our college. 10 teachers from our college appeared for NET / SET examination in the last academic year.

26. Increase in the Infrastructure facilities:

- a) The college has set up advanced eye-speak lingua lab for the students of certificate course in spoken English.
- b) The Physics laboratory has been renewed and made it in the most advanced form with the facility of research for research scholars.
- c) The office of the Hon. Chairman of our institute is renovated and extended with three different compartments for various purposes of the Institution.
- d) The college has built multipurpose hall for functions like cultural Programmes, gathering, lectures of the scholars for all students, workshops, seminars, conferences etc.
- e) Administrative office has been renovated.
- f) Vice-Principals cabin and Staff common room also renovated.

27. Technology – Up gradation

- i) The college has computerized the entire admission and examination process . The internet facility is there in the office, the library, computer department as well as in the department of Physics. Almost all teachers of our college registered their name for the on-line affiliation of N.M.U. Jalgaon.

28. Financial aid to students:

- i) The college poor boys fund from which the poor and needy students are helped. The college provides fund for such students to purchase the books, to pay hostel fees and fund for boarding of such poor students.
- ii) The college runs Earn and Learn scheme for poor boys. The college gives remuneration for the students those who work and earn money by doing jobs like cleaning the laboratory apparatus, clean the campus, take care of plants in the garden, performing duties in the reading room and in the office work.

30. Activities and support from the Parent - Teacher association:

Every year the college organizes Parent-Teacher Gathering. This year also one such gathering was organized on 20th Sept. 2010 in the presence of Hon. Shri. Harishbhai Agrawal, One of the director of our Institute. The parents expressed their views, expectations, drawbacks about the college and suggested some new ideas for improving standard. One of the parent suggested to improve the facilities for the students like providing Aqua filtered water and separate reading rooms for boys and girls. Some parent also appreciated the efforts of the faculty members in teaching and congratulated the departments from which the students achieved genuine success like securing place in the merit list of the University or winning the medals.

31. Health Services :

The college provides the following health services for the students.

- i) The college with the help of Deputy Civil Hospital and Private Doctors conducts Medical checkup of every new student. i.e. The first year students.
- ii) The college has well equipped first aid box.
- iii) The department of Zoology conducts blood group detection camps for for the students of the college every year.
- iv) The college provides pure drinking water for the staff and for that the new Reverse Osmosis system Water Filter is purchased. There is a water cooler for students in the library area. One such RO System is also provided to the ladies hostel.
- v) The college time and again, send students to the hospital to donate blood for needy patients.
- vi) The college has advanced and well equipped health club, which is used by students, teachers and even by the citizens of the town. The sports persons are allowed to use these facilities free of charge.
- vii) The college implements the insurance scheme of the N.M.U. Jalgaon for students.

32. Performance in sports activities :

The college provides opportunity for students to develop and master their skills in various sports by providing the necessary basic facilities like equipments, ground and kits of various games. The Director of physical Education conducts practice session of various games every evening and guide students to enhance their performance in those games. The college teams are actively participate in intercollegiate tournaments of various games. Because of these efforts last year 8 students were selected for the Inter-University tournament to represent N.M.U. Jalgaon.

1. The college invites expert in administration, Computer and Internet operators to train the non- teaching staff. This helps non- teaching staff, specially newly recruited to learn and master the use of computer and internet.
2. Mr. A.V. Patil from the department of Mathematics guides the non-teaching staff for the On-line process of Examination and Admissions.

37. Healthy Practices of the Institution:

For the all round development of the students, to make them better and responsible citizen and to uplift the standard of education, there are number of healthy practices undertaken by the college. Some of these activities are mentioned below

i. To uplift the standard of education and make teaching-learning process effective, the college has formed QAC and IQAC Committees, consisting senior teachers, members of the management and two social representatives. These committees prepare plan to enhance the standard of education and keep an eye on the entire system of the college.

ii. The college also provides opportunity to those members of the society who could not get higher education for some reasons. For such people, the college runs Y.C.M.O. University Centre to give distant education. This centre provides the facilities of getting graduate degrees of B.A. and B.Com. In the last year more than five hundred people were benefited.

iii. The college runs with the financial assistance of UGC, Remedial coaching class scheme for S.T. and S.C. students. This scheme is of great assistance for those students for better understanding the difficult subjects and improving their performance in the examination. Last year more than 120 students were benefited by this scheme. The college received the grant of Rs. 3, 00,000/- for this purpose, out of which the college spent Rs. 2, 60,000/- on this scheme.

iv. Navapur taluka is a complete tribal taluka. Even our college strength is dominated by S.T. students. Almost 80% students of our college belong to the tribal community. Considering the backwardness and poor economical condition, geographical and social factors and lack of facilities, the college introduced various schemes and programmes to help the poor tribal students.

The college runs Eklavya Competitive Examination centre in collaboration with the North Maharashtra University. This centre guides tribal students for the M.P.S.C. and U.P.S.C. examinations by organizing lectures and workshops by experienced scholars and prepare the tribal students for various competitive examinations.

v. The college also runs 'Centre for Coaching and Career Planning'. This centre selects 100 students and organizes lectures and experts in various subjects on every Sunday through out the academic year.

vi. The college forms special committee, 'The Adivasi Student Welfare Committee'. To inculcate civic values, to remove inferiority complex from the tribal students, the committee organizes various Programmes.

vii. To impart value based education the college forms various committees like 'Vivek Vahini', 'Yuvati Sabha', 'Debate Committee', 'N.S.S.'. These committees prepare students for social service, for creating awareness among tribal people and society about various social problems. They also force young students to think about various social problems and express their views and opinion on them by organizing debate and elocution competition and group discussions.

viii. With the assistance of North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon and U.G.C., the college provides financial aid to economically poor students, those who are good at study and perform well. In the last academic year North Maharashtra University assisted 25 poor student by giving Rs. 500/- for each student. From the U.G.C. scheme the college helped 52 selected students from S.T.,S.C. and Minority Class. The college spent Rs. 82,000/- on those students.

ix. To assist the poor boys and girls and to inculcate the value of service, the college implements "Earn and Learn scheme" for the students those who are economically weak. The committee appointed by the college for this scheme introduced "Karmveer Bhaurao Patil Earn and Learn Scheme". In the last academic year 13 students were benefited by this scheme. The N.M.U. Jalgaon and the college gave Rs. 25,890/- to those students. The college also provides free hostel facility to poor students and frees Health Club Membership to the sport persons.

Part – C

Reports of committees/Bodies/Associations formed by the College :-

01) Debate committee:

To develop the oratory skills and provide stage for young boys and girls on various social issues, the college appoints Debate committee every year. This committee organizes elocution, debate competition on various subjects. It also helps students to develop the thinking ability.

This year the inaugural function was organized on 10th Aug. 2010. Shri B.P. Jadhav, Head of English department was the chief guest. He delivered the inaugural speech on “How to develop the oratory skills and win the elocution and debate competitions”.

The debate committee organized a local elocution competition to celebrate Ganesh festival on the subject “Ganesh festival in the past, present and future”. Ten students participated in this competition.

Every year Debate committee organizes Inter-Collegiate debate competition in the memory of Late Shri Dwarkaprasad Hansalaji Agrawal on 12th January. This year the competition organized on the theme “The policy of the government is responsible for various scams”. Twelve different colleges participated in the competition. The trophy given in the memory of Seth Dwarkaprasad was won by B.Ed college of MARCH institute, Navapur. The best three speeches were awarded with cash prizes of Rs. 1001/-, 701/- and 501/- respectively.

Prof. B.B. Kuwar, the chairman of this committee and members Prof. R.A. Pathan, Dr. R.A. Mali, Prof. Y.G. Bhadane, Prof. Mrs. S.B. Bansode and Prof. Miss Urvi Thakkar organized the competitions successfully.

02) Earn and Learn Scheme:

The college designs this committee to help those students whose economical condition is poor. The committee selects the poor students and asks them to perform some duties after their college hours and pay them for their work.

This year the committee introduced “Karmveer Bhaurao Patil Earn and Learn scheme” in collaboration with North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon. Thirteen students were benefited by this scheme. These selected poor students performed duties like cleaning laboratory apparatus, gardening, performing duty in the library reading room, cleaning and maintain the college campus etc. The N.M.U. Jalgaon gave Rs. 17,568/- to these students and our college spent Rs. 8,322/- on three poor students.

03) Students Welfare Committee:

For the all round development of personality of students the college appoints this committee. This committee organizes various workshops, seminars and lectures of scholars for the students.

This year this committee implemented the scheme introduced by North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon. The scheme is for students from SC, ST and OBC category. The committee selected 25 poor students whose performance in examination was good and aided them with the fund of Rs. 11,500/- provided by the N.M.U. Jalgaon.

This committee in collaboration with student's welfare department, North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon organized three days workshop on friendship with various aspects of life (Maitri Shibir). In this university level workshop 120 students from various

colleges participated. This workshop was inaugurated by Dr. N.K. Thakare, the ex-Vice-Chancellor. Dr. K.B. Patil, the present Vice-Chancellor was the chief guest for the valedictory function. The former Management Council member of the University Dr. L.A. Patil, Dr. P.D. Deore, Prof. L.G. Sonavane, Prof. Shriram Dautkhane, Prof. A.K. Birade, Dr. Himanshu Jaiswal, and Prof. Vilas Chavan delivered lectures on various aspects in this workshop.

04) Career and Counseling Committee:

To prepare our student for the competitive exam and to guide them for making their career, the college appoints this committee. Prof. S.R. Borse from the department of Physics was the chairman of this committee. He with the help of other members of the committee organized the following programmes.

- 1} One day workshop on “ Personality Development”. Shri Krishna Patil from Pune was the resource person.
- 2} One day workshop on “ Mastering English Language”. It was conducted by Shri Leela Pandit from Mumbai.
- 3} Lecture series was organized in collaboration with Asha foundation, Jalgaon. Shri Girish Kulkarni and Shri Baviskar delivered lectures on different topics Every Sunday.

05) Staff Academy:

To update the faculty, the college invites eminent personalities to guide the faculty. 19) Committee for Hostel Accomodation and Conveyance Allowance to poor and S.T/ SC Students:

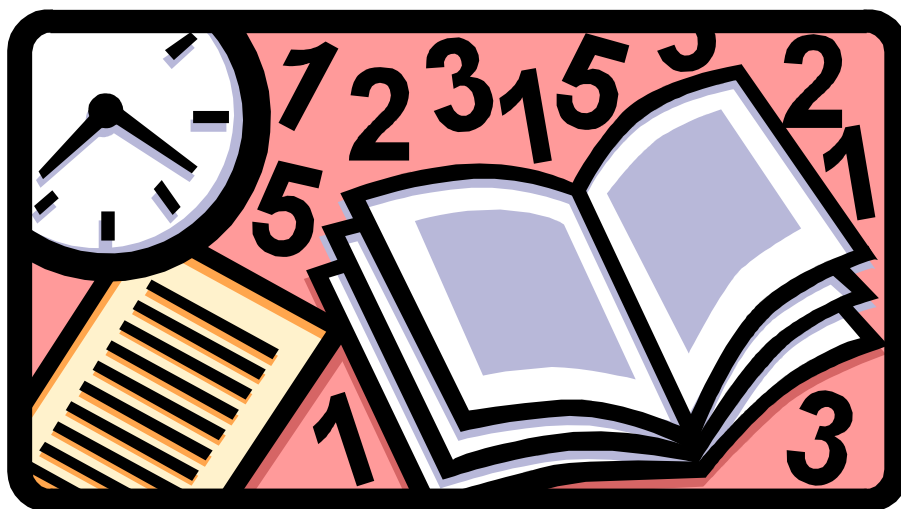
