One memorable event that three teachers of our college Mr.B.B.Kuwar, Mr.H.N.Kamble and Mrs.S.B.Bansode are rewarded with Manav Seva Ratna Puraskar.

The successful implementation of these activities has been possible only due to the impartial and democratic functioning of our management which the peer Team has also appreciated.

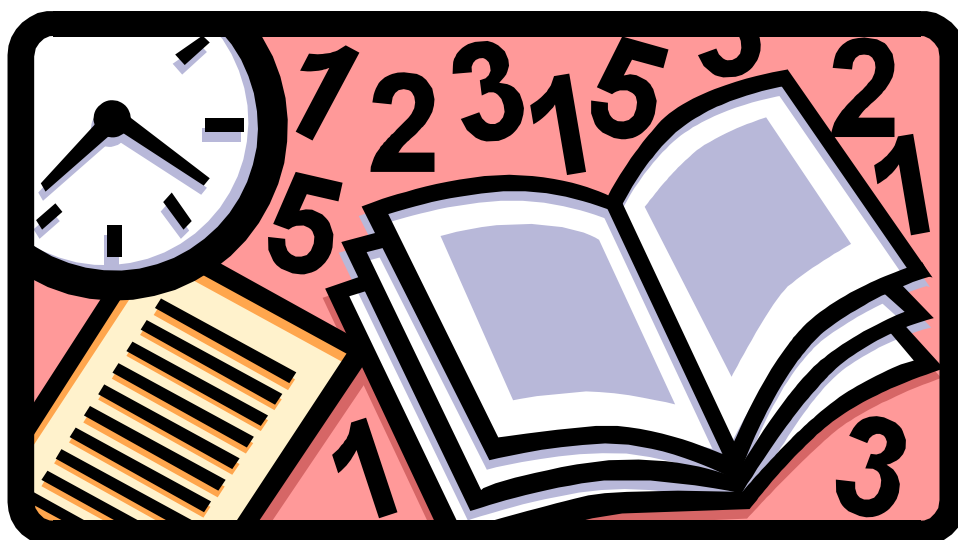

36. **Activities of the Guidance and Counseling Unit:**

The unit organizes G.K. lectures every week throughout the Academic year. Besides, the unit also functions as the mentor unit informally counseling the students about their admission procedures, infrastructure and academic facilities, creating awareness about the environmental issues and other students related issues. In this the unit is helped by the Parents Teacher Association.

37. **Placement services provided to students:**

The career counseling Unit helps students to find placement services. It finds out job opportunity through Internet, Magazines, News papers and show cases employment information on notice board. The centre personally guides the students as to how to fill in the application form how to prepare for the exams and interview. It also conducts the mock interviews.

38. **Development programmes for Non-Teaching Staff:**

- i. Non-Teaching Staff members are provided training from time to time to up-date their computer knowledge. For that purpose the college invites computer experts.
- ii. Computer Teacher of our college Mrs.Kavita Khankari provides guidance and help in the application of computer in the office work.

39. **Healthy practices of the institution:**

- i. The college has established a system of quality checks as regards to teaching, learning and administration through the democratization of functioning at various levels of the institutions's management and administration. With this view the college has from 2004-05, set up QAC and IQAC to facilitate the implementation and supervision of this process of democratization of institution's functioning.
- ii. As a social responsibility, the college is ever ready to come up with help and support for any healthy programme. This year the college collected the contributory amount Rs.5000/- from the counselors of study centre of Navapur college and sent the amount to Y.C.M.O. University, Nasik for the organization of Ashwamedh Sport Tournament.

- iii. The college runs the Distance Education programme of Yeshwantrao Chavan Maharashtra Open University, Nasik.
- iv. The college from time to time organizes rallies to collect funds for the victims of earthquake, flood, drought, tsunami and others natural calamities.
- v. The college has evolved different practices to impart value based education like taking national, social, religious and economic issues for debate competitions arranging lectures of eminent personalities, celebrating festivals and some important days and events. Various activities of N.S.S. and other committees set up in the college are organized with a view to inculcate values among the students. These are like observation and celebration of important days and festivals like Raksha Bandhan, Ramzan Id, Christmas, Good Friday, Children's Day, Hindi Day, Mother's Day, Father's Day, Teacher's Day, Geography Day, Sadbhavana Rally, organizing blood donation and blood detection camp, AIDS awareness Rally, Environment Awareness Rally etc.
- vi. Our College in general and its N.S.S. unit and Vivek Vahini in particular undertake various activities to inculcate civic responsibilities in students. For example every year during the Ganesh Festival and other public festivals our N.S.S. and Vivek Vahini volunteers visit the festival spots and collect the waste material and convert it into compost Besides this they also create public awareness about pollution free environment by orienting people during such festivals. These committees organize AIDS Awareness programmes and Rallies, participate in pulse polio campaign various activities are undertaken like cleanliness drive, organizing programmes to drive superstitions and blind beliefs and inculcating scientific attitude, organizing various programmes to maintain the communal harmony and strengthen the feeling of national integrity among the multi religious and multi cultural students of Navapur by taking out rallies and arranging lectures to create environmental awareness.
- vii. The Vivek Vahini of our college is doing commendable work to eradicate the superstitions, blind beliefs and evil practices in this predominantly illiterate, ignorant and superstitious tribal community. The results of the activities of this committee are visible

in many tribal villages where tribals are gradually shifting away from the evil practices.

- viii. The activities are undertaken for prevention of alcoholism, drug addiction and tobacco consumption that are so rampant in this area.
- ix. This year the college provided internet facility to the students and all the faculty members free of cost. The college, with a view to inculcate the values and civic responsibilities in students, forms various committees. Following are the details of those committees and the various activities undertaken by them.

1. **Annual Social Gathering Committee**

This year the college celebrated Annual Social Gathering on 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> January 200. The students of the college exhibited their hidden artistic skills through their participation in the various entertaining social cultural programmes. Two participants selected from the cultural programmes were sent to represent at Youth festival of North Maharashtra University held at Faizpur College.

2. **N.S.S. Committee:**

Activities inculcating social responsibilities and values with a view to develop all round personality of students are conducted through N.S.S. This year N.S.S. Special winter camp with the theme of Healthy Youth for Healthy Nation was organized. The N.S.S. volunteers of our unit also make notable representation in the outdoor programmes.

3. **Gymkhana Committee:**

Activities keeping the students physically and mentally fit are organized through this committee.

4. **Library Committee:**

Library committee has been formed with an intention to oversee smooth functioning of library services to the students. The committee provides book bank facility to the needy students. This year 20 students have been provided with 73 books under this scheme. The committee has also Annual Best Library Users Award to drive majority of students towards the library. The results of this award are visible. Every year the Librarian conducts the survey to find out the number of library users. This year 78.42% of students used the library facility. The committee has opened up library facilities to the Alumni and the outsiders as well.

5. **Debate Committee:**

Debate on burning issues are held through this committee with a view to make students aware of the contemporary social, religious, economic, political, national and international issues. The committee for the last 18 years has been organizing the state level debate competition in memory of late Shri.Dwarkaprasad Hansalalji Agrawal, the founding member of the institution. The committee organizes competitions at college level and also



provides encouragement to the students to participate in debate competitions organized by other colleges and institutions.

6. **Adivasi Students Welfare Committee:**

The activities of the committee are concerned with the welfare of Adivasi students. In this regard the committee showcases various Governmental welfare schemes for Adivasi students and also arranges lectures inviting the authorities from welfare department.

7. **Planning Forum:**

Activities developing commercial and entrepreneurial skills are organized this committee. This year the committee organized three lectures of Eminent persons on commercial issues. The committee also holds the post budget discussion among the students with a view to increase their interest in the various budget related issues.

8. **Eklavya Magazine and Adirang Wall Paper:**

These help to develop the literary writing skills among students. The students are encouraged to contribute burning issues which are included in Eklavya magazine or Adirang wall paper. This year the Adirang wall paper committee published three special issues. .

9. **Tour Committee:**

The committee arranges various study tours. This year following departments arranged the 'educational tours.

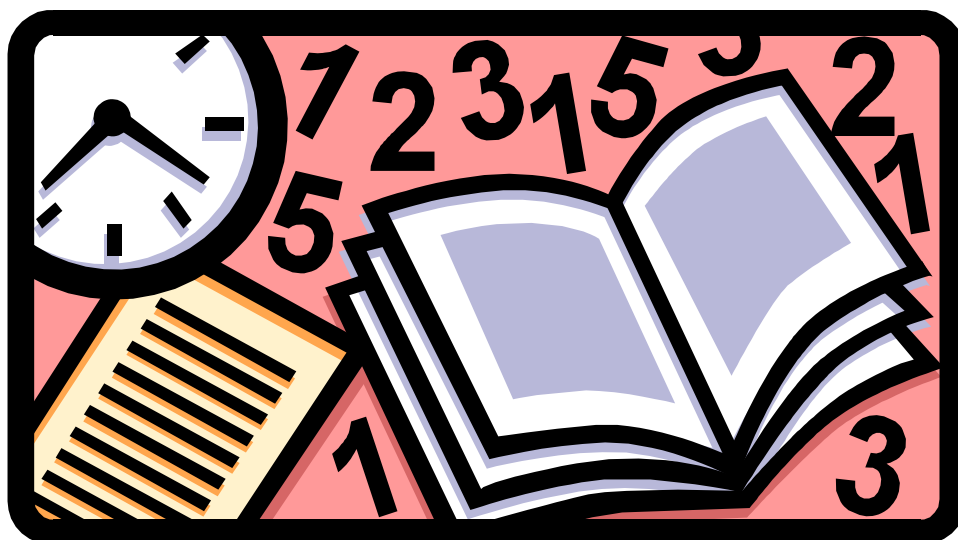
